


#### Barcelona

#### City bathed by the Mediterranean

Barcelona is the **most cosmopolitan** city, located on the shores of the Mediterranean Sea. It is a paradise of culture and architecture, featuring modernist masterpieces such as La Pedrera and Park Güell by the renowned architect Antoni Gaudí, both declared World Heritage Site by **UNESCO**.

Barcelona offers a vast array of activities to explore its most iconic neighborhoods, such as the Gothic Quarter, Eixample, Sagrada Familia, Gracia, Sants, Poblenou, and Barceloneta.

**Catalan cuisine** consists of countless recipes whose main elements are **locally sourced and seasonal ingredients**, giving the dishes intense flavors, as well as endless aromas and textures.







#### Location

The location of the restaurant is extraordinary: **near the sea, between the Born and Barceloneta neighborhoods**, serving as a reference point both for the city's residents and for those visiting the Catalan capital.

Privileged location between the Born and Barceloneta neighborhoods, an area with a unique charm that combines history and modernity.

Just a few steps from the restaurant, you'll find some of the city's main attractions, such as the Picasso Museum and the MOCO Museum (5 minutes on foot), the Basilica of Santa Maria del Mar (5 minutes on foot), and Ciutadella Park (10 minutes on foot). Additionally, the area is perfectly connected to the Gothic Quarter and Las Ramblas, just a 10-15 minute walk away, while the iconic Barceloneta Beach is only 15 minutes on foot.

7 Portes is also close to the city's main hotels, such as Hotel Arts, Hotel W Barcelona, and several establishments on Passeig de Gràcia, all within a 10-15 minute drive. This privileged location, combined with its historical and culinary prestige, makes it the ideal venue for corporate events and business lunches or dinners

### History

**7 Portes** is one of Barcelona's most iconic restaurants. Its stoves have been burning for **188 years**, always preserving the essence of Catalan cuisine while embracing influences from international gastronomy.

In 1980, the Solé Parellada family took over the management of the restaurant, continuing the more than 300 years of culinary tradition of the Parellada family.

The restaurant was honored by the Barcelona City Council with the **Gold Medal for Civic Merit**, recognizing its long-standing connection to the city and its role as a key meeting place for journalists, intellectuals, and politicians, among others. In 2023, it received the **Award for Iconic Barcelona Businesses**, reaffirming its contribution to the preservation of the city's historical and cultural heritage.

From the beginning, 7 Portes, has been linked to culture, both gastronomic and with literary arts, painting, music, among others.









#### Our cuisine

The most representative dishes of 7 Portes are **the rice and paella dishes**, with more than 12 types, such as the Paella Parellada, in addition to classics like Mrs. Carme's cod or the monkfish a la *barquera*. However, our menu offers nearly **80 à la carte dishes**, made with the highest quality ingredients, which are an excellent example of traditional Catalan cuisine.

We also invite you to be surprised by our desserts, all handmade, prepared daily in the restaurant's pastry kitchen.

**Wine** lovers will find a carefully curated cellar with **over 100 varieties**, both national and international, all of exquisite quality, which we serve with care and pride to complement a perfect evening.

We have **intimate private rooms** with a maximum capacity of four people and **large lounges** that can accommodate up to 80 diners.


Additionally, the unique Porxos de'n Xifré, which lead into the restaurant, offer a magnificent terrace for hosting personalized events.

We are at your disposal to provide the space that best suits your needs.










